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**ORDER GRANTING RECEIVER'S SECOND MOTION TO EXCUSE COMPLIANCE  
WITH 11 U.S.C. § 543**

THIS MATTER came before the Court on July 9, 2026, at 2:00 p.m. upon the *Receiver's Second Motion to Excuse Compliance with 11 U.S.C. § 543* [Dkt. No. 227] ("**Motion**") filed by Michael S. Budwick, in his capacity as receiver for the Debtors<sup>1</sup> ("**Receiver**"). By prior orders, the Court excused the Receiver from compliance with 11 U.S.C. § 543, first through April 22, 2026 [Dkt. No. 31], and then through August 21, 2026 [Dkt. No. 90]. The Court reviewed the Motion, considered the record, heard argument, and noted that no objection to the Motion was

filed and that the Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors supports the requested relief. Accordingly, finding good cause, it is

**ORDERED** as follows:

1. The Motion is **GRANTED** as follows.
2. The Receiver is excused from compliance with 11 U.S.C. § 543(a) and (b) and is authorized to remain in possession, custody, and control of the Debtors and property of the Debtors' estates unless and until this Court orders otherwise.
3. The Debtors are debtors in possession in these jointly administered Chapter 11 cases and the Receiver holds all corporate decision-making authority over them including the authority to direct the Debtors in these Chapter 11 proceedings.
4. The Court reserves jurisdiction to hear and determine all matters arising from or related to the implementation of this Order.
